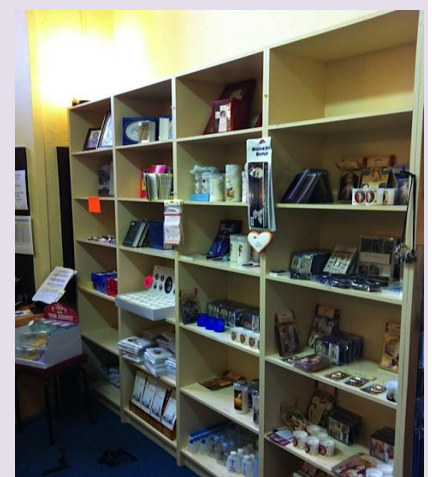
The Parish Office and Shop
