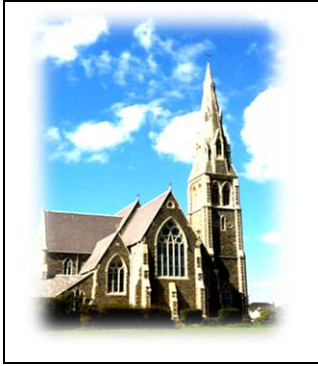

PARISH STUDY GROUP OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

A three-year programme based on the course notes from Maryvale Institute, Birmingham that seeks to cover the entire Catechism, in the context of informal adult faith formation. Its aim is to help adults to deepen their knowledge of the Catholic faith and thus to better appreciate why we believe what we do.

It is currently being piloted in the Diocese of Waterford & Lismore in a number of areas such as St Paul's, Waterford, Clonmel and Dungarvan. It is already up and running in a number of parishes throughout the country and has already been very successful.

Bishop Cullinan is currently exploring the possibility of setting up such a parish group here in Tramore, for adults, both young and old, who would be interested and willing to deepen the knowledge of their faith, in a group setting with other adults.
