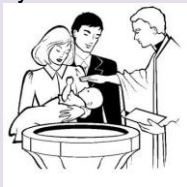

The Parish Council are organising a Table Quiz on **Thursday 12th May at 8pm.**

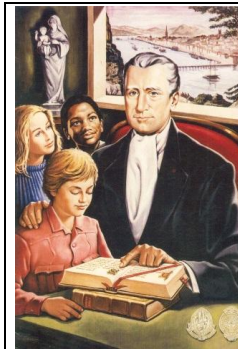
Tramore Golf Club have kindly agreed to host the event. This is designed to be a fun night open to both young and old.

Opening night, Tuesday May 3rd: Mass celebrated by Fr. Robert Grant PP. Ballybeg. The guest speaker will be Ms. Monica Reilly. Monica is a member of the Christian Brothers Spirituality Group. The choir on Tuesday will be the Cathedral Vigil choir led by Caroline Reid-O'Brien

On Wednesday 4th May the Edmund Rice Camp Leaders based here in Mount Sion will lead a Retreat session.
