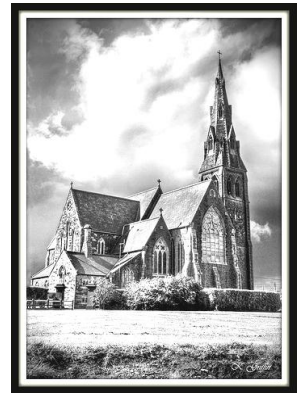

If you are planning to marry during 2017. The following 'to dos' might help to make things run smoothly.

Book the Church with your preferred date and time.

Contact the priest of the parish to do some preliminary form filling.

Attend a Pre Marriage Course run by Accord. These courses are run in St John's Pastoral Centre, John's Hill, Waterford and can be booked on line

(Email [accordwaterford@eircom.net](mailto:accordwaterford@eircom.net)).

You will need to give notice to the Registrar of Births & Marriages.

The priest who will officiate at your marriage will guide you through the preparation for the marriage ceremony, which if well prepared can be one of the highlights of your day.

If you are planning to marry outside of Ireland it is important that you also contact the priest in good time so that the requirements of the foreign state are observed.
