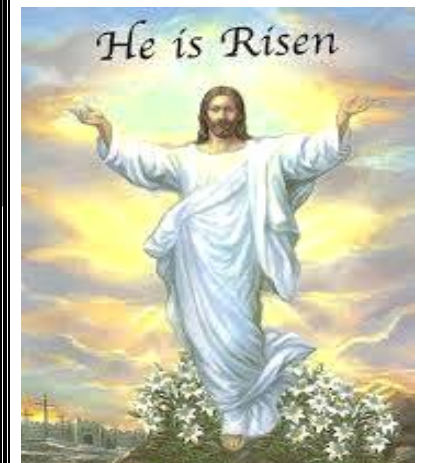

Easter Message 2025

Friends, over the last week, we have journeyed with Christ through His passion and suffering, and now we celebrate His victory over all that tried to eliminate Him and destroy His message and example. In our celebrations, we linked our own lives and struggles, and those of our families and community to Christ. We poured out our own worries, as Christ poured out His life; and in His rising we took strength, consolation, and hope to cope with all that we carry too.
