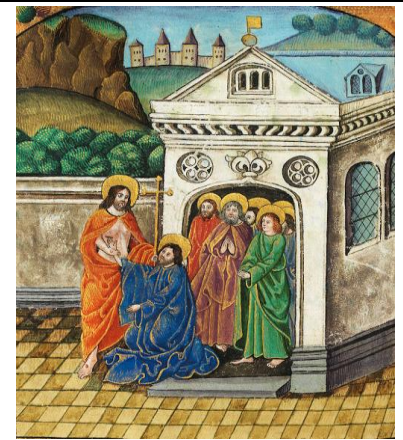

On the morning following the joyous celebrations of Easter throughout the world, we were awakened by the painful announcement that Pope Francis had died.

Our hearts are saddened by the passing of a man whose tremendous faith and vision shepherded the Church through many challenges over the course of the past 12 years.

Pope Francis came from the periphery, as the first Pope from the Americas, and those at the periphery – the poor, the migrant, the prisoner, the refugee, the outcast – were always at the centre of his pontificate. Only last Holy Thursday, despite his own frailty, he took time to visit Rome's Regina Coeli prison and his first visit outside Rome as Pope was to the tiny island of Lampedusa to remember the many drowned at sea, in search of refuge and a new beginning on mainland Europe.

Pope Francis will be remembered for many things and there will be much commentary over the next while, but his message of inclusion and mercy was key. "The name of God is mercy" he reminded us.

Although we now grieve, we commend him to the mercy of God and we take solace in the words of the Risen Christ who asks His followers, "Do not be afraid."

As people of faith, we turn to the One who is the Resurrection and the Life and ask him to receive Pope Francis into the halls of the heavenly banquet and to give him eternal rest.
