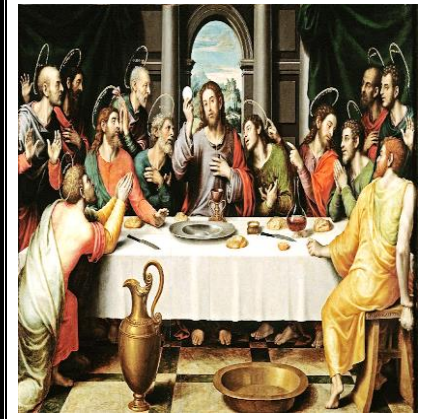

## Reflection for the 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

In a family so much love is lavished on the new-born first child, and you hear them saying that's the end of freedom now for a good few years. Or the grandchildren come and there's the babysitting. Life deepens love and narrows our freedom. Jesus says elsewhere that love is the door to eternal life.

In laying down life for a friend, the cross was a narrow door.
